

6 <sup>th</sup> Kyu	3 months	3 months
5 <sup>th</sup> Kyu	3 months after receiving the 6 <sup>th</sup> Kyu 1 RT CAA or NT CAA	6 months
4 <sup>th</sup> Kyu	6 months after receiving the 5 <sup>th</sup> Kyu 2 RT CAA or NT CAA	12 months
3 <sup>rd</sup> Kyu	6 months after receiving the 4 <sup>th</sup> Kyu 2 RT CAA or NT CAA	18 months
2 <sup>nd</sup> Kyu	9 months after receiving the 3 <sup>rd</sup> Kyu 3 RT CAA or NT CAA	27 months
1 <sup>st</sup> Kyu	12 months after receiving the 2 <sup>nd</sup> Kyu 3 RT CAA or NT CAA including SS or WS CAA	39 months
1 <sup>st</sup> Dan	12 months after receiving the 1 <sup>st</sup> Kyu minimum age of 18 2 NT CAA or 1 NT CAA + 1 RT CAA & 1 CAA Summer School & 1 CAA Yudansha	4 – 5 years
2 <sup>nd</sup> Dan	6 NT CAA or 4 NT CAA + 2 RT CAA & 3 CAA Summer Schools & 3 CAA Yudansha	7 – 8 years
3 <sup>rd</sup> Dan	8 NT CAA or 5 NT CAA + 3 RT CAA & 4 CAA Summer Schools & 4 CAA Yudansha/Shidoshakai	11 – 12 years
4 <sup>th</sup> Dan	together with recommendation of CAA TC 10 NT CAA or 6 NT CAA + 4 RT CAA & 5 CAA Summer Schools & 5 CAA Yudansha/Shidoshakai	16 – 17 years
